3. VISA FORMALITIES

From 1st Jan 2018, Nationals of all countries receive visa on arrival at Kigali International Airport and all land borders.

Visa Policy Overview

- Visa on Arrival: Nationals of all countries are eligible to obtain a visa upon arrival at Kigali International Airport and all land borders.
- Visa Fee Waivers: Citizens of countries that are members of the African Union, Commonwealth, and La Francophonie are granted a visa upon arrival and are exempt from visa fees for a stay of up to 30 days.
- East African Community (EAC) Nationals: Citizens of EAC member states receive a pass/entry visa free of charge upon arrival for a stay of up to six months.

4. ACCOMMODATION

7. LOCAL TRANSPORT

Public Buses in Kigali

- **Modern Bus System:** Kigali's public buses are operated by multiple licensed companies, offering increased frequency and coverage across the city.
- **Payment System:** To board, passengers use a "Tap & Go" smart card, which can be purchased and recharged at taxi parks or bus stops.
- **Route Information:** Buses display their routes on digital screens, making it easy for passengers to identify their destinations.

Taxis and Ride-Hailing Apps

- **Traditional Taxis:** Available in major towns, though less common in rural areas. It's advisable to agree on a fare before starting the journey.
- **Ride-Hailing Services:** Mobile Apps like Yego cabs and Move are popular in Kigali, offering convenient booking and fare estimation.

Yego cabs and move Rwanda provide transparent pricing without surge charges. Their fare structure is as follows:

- Initial Fare: RWF 1,500 for the first kilometer
- **Subsequent Kilometers:** RWF 600 per kilometer
- Beyond 30 Kilometers: RWF 500 per kilometer

8. CURRENCY

The local currency: 1 United States Dollar is approximately 1430 Rwandan franc.



Recommendation:

Following the fact that Exchange rates can fluctuate due to various economic factors. It's advisable to monitor rates closer to your travel date for the most accurate information. Ensure that you use reliable resources

Currency Exchange Services: Consider exchanging currency at official bureaus or banks to ensure fair rates.

Local Currency Needs: While major currencies like USD and EUR are widely accepted, having local currency (RWF) is beneficial for small transactions and in areas where foreign currencies might not be accepted.

10. BUSINESS AND SHOPPING HOURS

Public and private Offices: Typically, open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday, with a one-hour lunch break.

General Shops: Most shops are open from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday to Saturday. Many shops close early on Saturdays and remain closed on Sundays

Supermarkets and shopping malls: These establishments often have extended hours and may remain open 7 days a week, including Sundays

Delegates may seek further advice from their hotels on the nearest shopping facilities.

11. LANGUAGE

English and Kinyarwanda are the official languages in Rwanda.

12. LOCAL TIME

Kigali operates on Central Africa Time (CAT), which is UTC+2.

13. WEATHER

August is characterized by clear skies, comfortable temperatures, and minimal rainfall, making it an ideal time for outdoor activities, sightseeing, and exploring Kigali's attractions. This make it one of the most comfortable months to visit Kigali.

Temperature

Daytime Highs: Around 26.8°C (80.2°F)

Nighttime Lows: Approximately 16.3°C (61.3°F)

Average Daily Temperature: 21.7°C (71°F)

14. PLUGS AND VOLTAGE

In Kigali, the standard voltage is 230V with a frequency of 50Hz. The power plugs and sockets used are primarily of Type C and Type J.





Type C: This is the standard two-pronged plug.



Type J: This plug has three round pins and.

Travel Tips

- Adapters: If your devices have plugs that don't match Type C or J sockets, bring a universal travel adapter.
- Voltage Converter: For single-voltage appliances, ensure you have a voltage converter.
- Hotel Amenities: Many hotels in Kigali provide plug adapters upon request, but it's advisable to carry your own.

15. DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Road Conditions and Driving Tips

- Road Quality: Kigali boasts a well-maintained road network, with most major roads being paved. However, some secondary roads may be unpaved or under construction. It's advisable to use a 4WD vehicle if planning to travel to rural areas.
- Driving Side: Vehicles in Rwanda drive on the right-hand side of the road. Ensure you're familiar with this if you're accustomed to driving on the left.
- **Speed Limits:** In urban areas, speed limits typically range from 40 to 60

- km/h, while on highways, they can go up to 80 km/h. Adhering to these limits is crucial, as traffic violations are monitored and fines are issued accordingly.
- **Traffic Rules:** Seat belts are mandatory for all occupants. Using a mobile phone while driving is prohibited. Always be vigilant for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorcyclists, especially in busy areas.
- **Warning:** In Rwanda, it's imperative to ensure that anyone operating a vehicle holds a valid and appropriate driver's license. Allowing or permitting someone without the proper authorization to drive can lead to serious legal consequences.
